Dear Students, Parents & Guardians

Thank you for your interest in the ROW Programme.

As outlined in the attached brochure, the programme runs on Saturday mornings between 8am and 10.30am and is based at Roberts House, 24 Orchard Ave, Boreen Point (our church in Boreen Point). Our next session begins on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> October (continuing until 6<sup>th</sup> December).

The programme is open to all high school students, however due to the specialized nature of the training requirements (we want all students to have access to a single sculling boat for the first term), a maximum of six students can commence each term. A priority is given to teenagers who do not otherwise have this kind of opportunity - perhaps due to the costs, lack of home support - and young people who have experienced abuse or violence in the home.

To express your interest in participating in our next session, we'd appreciate it if you could fill in the attached form and mail it to the Parish Office at 1 Rectory St, Pomona 4568 *before September 30<sup>th</sup> 2008*. You will be contacted prior to the start to confirm your place and to advise you what to bring.

The Anglican Church requires that all adults working with children obtain a 'Blue Card' and attend a briefing on the *Diocesan Child Protection Policies and Safe Ministry Practices*. If you have any concerns at any time, please speak with me directly.
